




Alcohol in L.A. City

L.A.'s primary public health and safety challenge related to the retail alcohol environment:

OVERCONCENTRATION

ALCOHOL IN L.A.

C12 of 16 Los Cogeles NDS: top tier for incidence of three or more alcohol-related harms

- 7 of 15 CDs: top tier for rated of violent crime
- 10 of 15 CDs: top tier for rates of dealth
- 14 or 15 CDs: top tier for alcohol-related hospitalizations

WHAT ARUS IS





L.A. City Council File #17-0117

PURPOSE: TO PREVENT THE FURTHER OVER-CONCENTRATION OF ALCOHOL RETAILERS IN SENSITIVE USE ARES WHERE THE RETAIL SALE OF ALCOHOL HAS A NEGATIVE IMPACT.

RESTRICT

New licenses in designated areas

SUPERSEDES

Existing regulations

APPLIES

To on-sale or Off-sale or Both **EXISTING LICENSES**

Doesn't effect existing licenses except in the vent that:

- premises change retail liquor license classification
- premises have 'substantial changes in mode or character of operation'

RANGE

From 1 block to 5 square miles

ARUS INITIATIVE













Criteria for ESTABLISHING anestablished 3 ways:

ARUSidue density of licenses (generally per capita)

- High crime/ nuisance activities
- Proximity to sensitive areas (schools, churches, parks, recreational areas)

- Simple majority vote of City Council
- Planning Commission/ Area Planning Commission
- Community Petitions:
 - o NCs to Planning or Area Planning
 - o General Public to Planning or Area **Planning**









- To ask for a letter of support be sent to the City of L.A.'s clerk for Council File# 17-0117
- To receive support that individual councils would consider being an ARUS community
- To ensure the community gets to have a voice when it comes to alcohol licensed establishments looking to operate in their neighborhoods
- To advocate for safe and healthy commnities
