Part I: Assessment of the Issue

- 1. How would you describe [issue] situation in [community]?
- 2. Please describe the severity of the issue.
- 3. Who is impacted by [issue]?
- 4. How has the issue changed over time?
- 5. What are the consequences?
- 6. When do the consequences occur (i.e., during what specific days of the week or times)?
- 7. What are the factors that drive the problem?

Part II: Steps to Address the Issue

- 1. What has the community done, if anything, to address [issue] in [community]?
- 2. What do you think should be done to address [issue] in [community]?
- 3. How well have these efforts worked?

Part III: Readiness to Address the Issue

- 1. What is your assessment of the level of readiness within [community] to address [issue]?
- 2. What is the level of interest in the issue?
- 3. What is the level of willingness to address the issue?
- 4. What factors might undermine or complicate this work?

Part IV: Resources to Address the Issue

- 1. What resources exist in the community to help address [issue]?
- 2. What is available in the community that can further benefit or support this effort? (e.g. community organizations, policies, protective factors)
- 3. What other individuals do you think we should talk to in order to obtain more information about [issue] in [community]?
